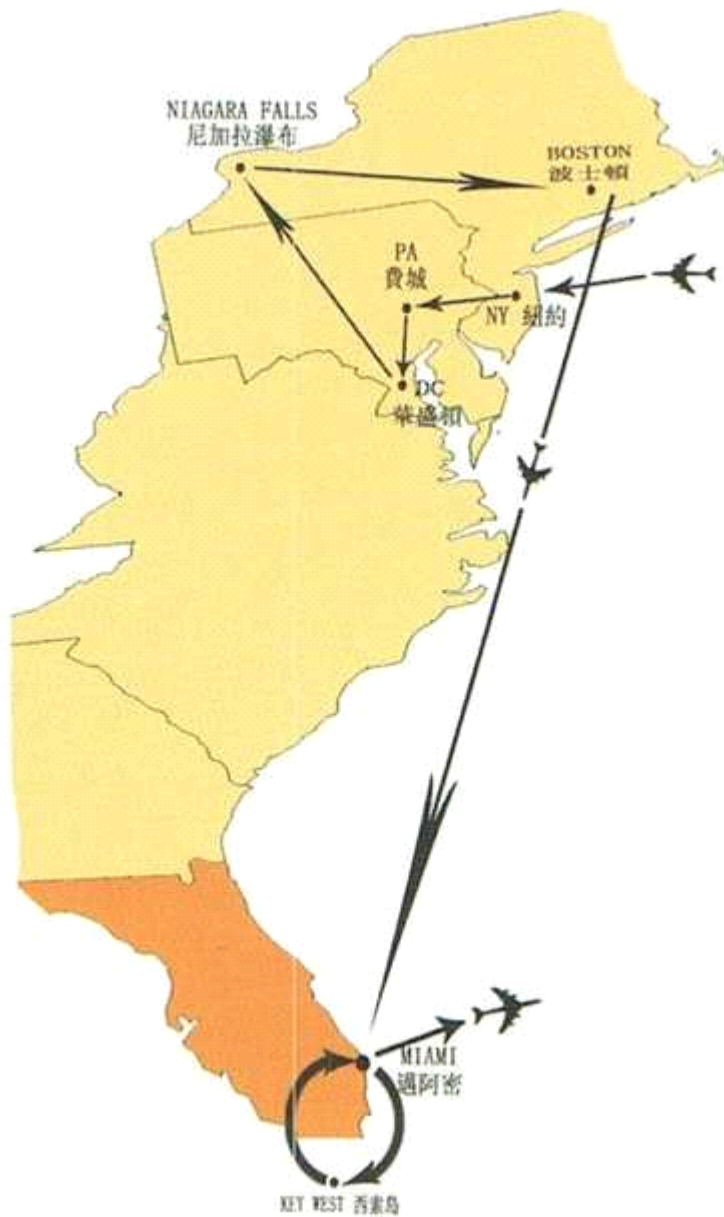

Besides stepping onto Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam and Korean War Memorials, our motorcoach takes you in town passing by the splendid Washington Monument and Jefferson Memorial. The National Air and Space Museum of the Smithsonian Institution, located in the same area called national Mall as the Capitol Hill, holds the largest collection of historic aircraft and spacecraft in the world in 161,145 square feet of exhibition floor space. Then you can choose either to stay in the Falls Park for self exploration until returning to the hotel or have an in-depth tour (\$25/Adult) by visiting the Hydropower Station and Old Fort Niagara. Come to the Old Fort Niagara, it will give you all the insights 99% tourists would never discover.
